Medical Rescue Team South (MRTSA) will be sponsoring an Emergency Medical Technician (EMT-B) course conducted by Community College of Allegheny County, Public Safety Institute (CCAC-PSI).

This course is scheduled to begin on September 21, 2008 and concludes on January 31, 2009.

The class will meet on Saturdays from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm in the Conference Center at Medical Rescue Team South, 315 Cypress Way, Pittsburgh, PA 15228-2218. Pennsylvania Department of Health Testing will follow completion of the course. The EMT Instructors for this course are personnel from MRTSA, MLFD and outside experts to cover specific specialty areas and are employed by CCAC-PSI.

EMTs are certified professionals able to help those individuals experiencing a medical emergency. EMT training is the foundation to becoming a Paramedic.

With the course being located at Medical Rescue Team's headquarters in Mt. Lebanon it is more convenient for the South Hills area students to attend the course rather than traveling to a distant course location. MRTSA offers a ride-a-long program on a MRTSA ambulance, which will permit the students an opportunity to refine the skills they are learning in class while being mentored by MRTSA EMTs and Paramedics as a member of the crew.

This course is open to the public and can become a stepping-stone to a career in Emergency Services.
