SEE CLASS DESCRIPTIONS ON OTHER SIDE

The following descriptions provide an outline of the topics covered in class.

ADULT/CHILD CPR/AED INFANT CPR This course teaches one rescuer CPR for the adult/child/infant victim, rescue breathing, obstructed airway, barrier devices, and AED (Automatic External Defibrillator) are taught.

HEALTHCARE PROVIDER or PROFESSIONAL RESCUER: This course is designed for those people who are in the healthcare and healthcare related fields as well as lifeguards. This course teaches one and two rescuer CPR for the adult, child and infant victims, rescue breathing, obstructed airways, barrier devices, airway adjuncts (Bag Valve Mask, Pocket mask) and AED. There is a written examination at the conclusion of this class.

FIRST AID BASICS: This course teaches First Aid skills such as splinting techniques; bleeding control, burn treatment, sudden illness and injury. This class has no prerequisites, and successful participants are certified in First Aid basics for two years.

MRTSA also has ACLS and PALS classes available for Healthcare Providers.
