



## **PARAMEDIC CLASS**

This 644 hour program is the second level required of training in the EMS career structure. This academic program will provide the students with the necessary didactic information, combined with the mandated clinical training to be eligible for the National Registry EMT Paramedic Certification Examination. This EMT Paramedic Training Program will require that all students register for XXB460 (Didactic Instruction) and XXB450 (Clinical Instruction) as co requisite classes for this program. The topics include in this class will include but not be limited to: Patient assessment; anatomy & physiology; respiratory and endocrine emergencies; cardiovascular and general medical emergencies; traumatic situations; shock and fluid therapy; infection diseases; pediatrics, geriatrics and neonatal emergencies.

CCAC adheres to the national standards that have been established that specifically define the role and performance criteria of the EMT-Paramedic. Based upon those standards, a curriculum was developed under the auspices of the US Department of Transportation (DOT). This "Training Program for EMT-Paramedic National Standard Curriculum" is used to train EMT-Paramedic personnel. Prerequisites: Current PA EMT Certification, 18 years of age and High School diploma or GED. NOTE: Enrollment in this program will include co-enrollment in the Clinical portion of the EMT Paramedic Program (XXB450). REQUIRED: Caroline Emergency Care in the Streets, 6th edition; publisher AAOS/Jones & Bartlett
